






Receiving requirements

The 'Receiving Dangerous Goods Checklist' can be used to remind us what needs to be in place.














Handling, storage and segregation requirements

During handling tasks, it is important to wear PPE, follow the Safety Data Sheet, maintain good hygiene and use an appropriate method to move the dangerous goods to their storage location.
